Malynda Cress's background is a unique blend of traditional education, alternative healing practices and personal experiences that have shaped her path as an end-of-life educator, speaker, death doula and advocate for the Unresponsive Dying. She was a Certified Hypnotherapist, Certified End-of-Life Doula, and Usui Reiki Master also trained in Karuna Reiki. She received her BA in Psychology from the University of NC at Chapel Hill.

A Spiritually Transformative Experience (STE) over 30 years ago, a Near Death Experience (NDE) years later, and the Shared Death Experiences (SDEs) that followed awakened her passion to assist the Unresponsive Dying. Her current work was founded in the SDE with her father. She served as a hospice volunteer for over ten years and encountered hundreds of SDEs in this role. Her greatest teachers are Unresponsive Individuals and the Light Beings who have stayed with her since her NDE.

Malynda's diverse background and experiences position her as a compassionate and holistic practitioner with a unique understanding of the dying process and the spiritual dimensions of life and death. She is dedicated to educating other practitioners and anyone interested in how to provide emotional, spiritual and practical support to create a dignified and seamless as possible transition.
