In complement to psychological perspectives, the world's wisdom traditions provide ample guidance on ways to proactively honor and welcome the support of the ancestors in these times of transition. Daniel Foor, Ph.D., is a teacher and practitioner of practical animism who specializes in ancestral and family healing and in helping folks learn to relate well with the rest of life. He is a Doctor of Psychology, marriage and family therapist, founder and director at Ancestral Medicine, and author of *Ancestral Medicine: Rituals for Personal and Family Healing*. His recent ancestors are settler-colonialists to North America from England, Germany, and Ireland, and he now lives with his wife and two daughters in Granada, Spain.
